Simple Rules

Planes: SkyRaider Mark II ARF and/or LA Racer ARF by World Model Company.

Engine: **Novice Class: Recommended: ST GS 40 with 11X4 MA prop** or Any small-frame, bushing engine, displacement of .40 or less cid. (FP clone) LAs, FPs, Tower .40, Magnum GP .40, Thunder Tiger GP .40 etc.

Advanced Class: Recommended – TT .40 Pro. - Acceptable: Any .40 cid "sport" engine, available locally at retail for under \$120.00. **No Jetts, no Nelsons, No special Racing Engines!!!!**

Both classes: Stock engine, stock carb, stock muffler. Must idle and must shut off on command.

Propeller: Have one, and maybe some spares. **Fuel:** SUPPLIED (15%) **Fees:** **\$10.00 per pilot, per class.**

Rewards: Mostly Bragging Rights. Will recognize Top Points, Fast Time, and Placing in "Features / Mains"

Course: Two-pylon, 400 ft. must fly out over the pylon area

Heats: Advanced Class - 4-plane heats, Novice Class – 3-plane heats. Both classes - Standing start, Ten Lap Heats.

We will run 4 rounds and then all pilots will fly in a "Feature/Main" as determined by fast times or total points.

These events will be in compliance with the AMA Safety Code.
